

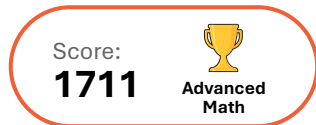
Assessment

Parents can view their child's STAAR results online at TexasAssessment.gov to see how their child is performing in school. Most parents can conveniently log in through their school's local parent portal. Beginning in the 2027-28 school year, STAAR will be replaced with a new state assessment.



ADVANCED MATH BADGE

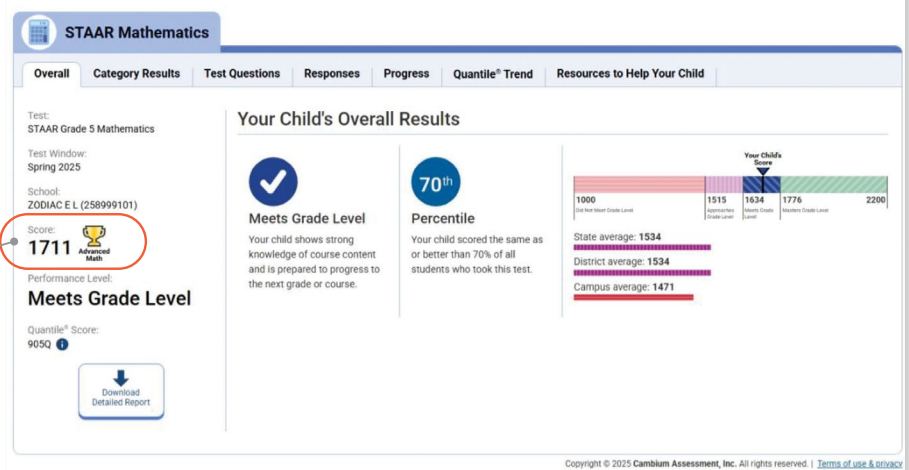
Thanks to the passage of Senate Bill 2124 (88R), students who perform well in elementary mathematics are automatically enrolled in advanced mathematics courses in middle school, while parents retain the right to opt out.
