 - **Prepare to Communicate: Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week**
[TEC §29.9074](#) requires the Governor to designate a week to be known as Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week in public schools to educate students about the dangers posed by the drug fentanyl and the risks of fentanyl poisoning, including overdose. Governor Abbott has designated the week of **October 12-18, 2025, as Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Week**. The week may include age-appropriate instruction, including instruction on the prevention of the abuse of and addiction to fentanyl, as determined by each school district.
 - **Prepare to Communicate: Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Month** [Texas Government Code, §662.116](#), establishes the month of October as Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Month to increase awareness of the dangers of fentanyl and potential overdoses. Fentanyl Poisoning Awareness Month may be regularly observed through appropriate community activities. The [Fentanyl Response Communications Toolkit](#) includes resources to support fentanyl poisoning awareness month that are available to help school systems plan and prepare to increase awareness during the month of October.
